

Candlemas, which occurs 40 days after Christmas on February 2nd, celebrates the **Presentation of the Lord in the Temple**. This was the day that, in keeping with Jewish law, Mary and Joseph brought the baby Jesus to the temple for the first time. Simeon, upon seeing the Child Jesus, says,

“For my eyes have seen your salvation which you prepared in sight of all the peoples, a **LIGHT** for revelation to the Gentiles, and glory for your people Israel.” (Luke 2:30-32)

From these words comes the Catholic tradition of blessing of the candles.
