## THE DESCENT OF CHRIST

In the Apostles' Creed we profess that Christ "suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried; he descended into hell..."

How is it possible for God the Son to suffer?

Did Christ still have the beatific vision, or the vision of heaven, when he endured his suffering?

Did he really descend into hell?

With the help of theologian Matthias Scheeben (1835-1888), we hope to answer these questions and more at this month's Oratory Lecture Series.
