Oratory Lecture Series




The Oratory Lecture Series Presents

What Fr. Reed's up to at Notre Dame

St. Teresa Benedicta of the Cross (Edith Stein) was a philosopher and a theologian, a Carmelite and a martyr. She was a genuinely original thinker, deeply influenced by both the Catholic medieval philosophical tradition, and modern understandings of consciousness and the self.
